Application(s): Suitable for most immunological methods requiring purified immunoglobulins.

Recommended Dilution(s): Not specified. Optimal titers for applications should be determined by the researcher.

Storage Conditions: Store vial at 4° C prior to restoration. Restore with 5.0 ml of deionized water (or equivalent). Centrifuge product if not completely clear after standing at room temperature. This product is stable for several weeks at 4° C as an undiluted liquid. Dilute only prior to immediate use. For extended storage aliquot contents and freeze at -20° C or below. Avoid cycles of freezing and thawing. Expiration date is one (1) year from date of restoration.

Purity: This product was prepared from normal serum by a multi-step process which includes delipidation, salt fractionation and ion exchange chromatography followed by extensive dialysis against the buffer stated above. Assay by immunoelectrophoresis resulted in precipitin arcs against anti-Bovine Serum corresponding to gamma globulins.
